- Travel Hwy. J to Hwy. U with a brief rest stop at Clark's Fork Lutheran Church 7 miles. ETA 10:45; leave by 11:00.
- Travel Hwy. U to Route B to Hartman Village to parade around facility. 10 miles, ETA 11:50.
- Travel Logan's Lake Road to Hwy. 5 to Sombart Road to Harley Park 4 miles. ETA 12:10 Lunch at Harley Park, Leave by 1:10.
- Morgan St., to Main St. to Locust St. past David Barton Elementary School 1.5 miles. ETA 1:20.
- Take Locust St. to 11th St. to Hwy. 87 to Hwy. 98 back to Brady Show Grounds. 9 miles. ETA 2:25.
- Total trip; 47 miles.

2024 Missouri River Valley Steam Engine Association (MRVSEA) Tractor Cruise Guidelines I, , hereby pledge

to hold safety as the highest priority on the MRVSEA tractor cruise. The safety of my fellow riders and the public traveling on the route is of the utmost importance. I pledge to obey the following guidelines.

- 1. To be 16 years of age with a valid drivers license.
- 2. To follow all traffic laws.
- 3. To not carry riders unless approved by the ride management team.
- 4. To not allow any alcohol at any time.
- 5. To stay with assigned group (no passing).
- 6. To depart during assigned group's designated time.
- 7. To drive on the shoulder whenever possible.
- 8. To not have bicycle companions or cars following.
- 9. To not pull trailers or campers.
- 10. To post a SMV sign (you will need to provide).
- 11. To follow designated route.
- 12. To abide by the decisions of the ride management team in the event of inclement weather.

I understand not abiding by these rules will result in the denial of future applications. Repetitive violators will be asked to leave the ride per the ride management team.
