When: Friday, September 5, 2025 9:00 A.M. Brady Show Grounds

Route: Approximately 39 miles

- Leave from Brady Show Grounds at 9:00 A.M.
- Travel Hwy. 179 & Hwy. 87 to Jamestown Lions Club Park – 16.6 miles. (Drive will take ~ 90 minutes; leave park by 11:00).
- Travel Highways D & U to Prairie Home; lunch at fairgrounds – 8.3 miles (Drive time ~ 45 minutes. Leave fairgrounds by 12:45)
- Travel Hwy. EE & 179 back to Brady Show Grounds – 14 miles (Drive time ~ 90 minutes)
- Optional – If back to Brady Show Grounds in time; drivers can drive through Daily Parade of Power.

Other: We will have a rest stop with donuts soft drinks at Jamestown Lions Club Park MRVSEA and Marty & Paula James. Lunch will be served at Prairie Home Fairgrounds.

Cost: If registered by 8/31/2025, \$35 entry fee includes all meals. \$40 after this date.

Tractor Cruise Guidelines I, _____, hereby pledge to hold safety as the highest priority on the MRVSEA tractor cruise. The safety of my fellow riders and the public traveling on the route is of the utmost importance. I pledge to obey the following guidelines.

1. To be 16 years of age with a valid driver's license.
2. To follow all traffic laws.
3. To not carry riders unless approved by the ride management team.
4. To not allow any alcohol at any time.
5. To stay with assigned group (no passing).
6. To depart during assigned group's designated time.
7. To drive on the shoulder whenever possible.
8. To not have bicycle companions or cars following.
9. To not pull trailers or campers.
10. To post a SMV sign (you will need to provide).
11. To follow designated route.
12. To abide by the decisions of the ride management team in the event of inclement weather.

I understand not abiding by these rules will result in the denial of future applications. Repetitive violators will be asked to leave the ride per the ride management team.
