



What: Missouri River Valley Steam Engine Association Classic Tractor Cruise

When: Friday, September 11, 2026 | 8:00 A.M. Brady Show Grounds

Route: Approximately 48 miles

- Leave from Brady Show Grounds at 8:30 A.M.
- Leg 1 - Travel Hwy. 98 to Boonville's Harley Park; via Main St. to Morgan St., Boonville – 11 miles, eta ~ 9:30 A.M. Leave Harley Park before 10:30.
- Leg 2 - Travel Santa Fe Trail Road to Hwy. 135 to Pilot Grove Park for lunch – 13 miles. Eta ~ 11:45. Leave Pilot Grove Park by 12:45 P.M.
- Leg 3 - Travel Hwy. M to Hwy. OO to Hwy. 135 & I-70 Intersection, rest stop at Fertilizer Dealer Supply – 9 miles eta ~ 1:40 P.M. Leave by 2:15.
- Leg 4 - Travel Old Hwy. 40 to Hwy. 5 to Hwy. 87 to Hwy. 98 to Brady Show Grounds – 15 miles eta ~ 3:30.

Other: We will have a rest stop with donuts, coffee and soda at Harley Park. Lunch will be at the Pilot Grove Park and the after-lunch restroom break will be sponsored by Fertilizer Dealer Supply.

Cost: If registered by 8/31/2026, \$35 entry fee includes all meals. \$40 after this date.

Tractor Cruise Guidelines I, _____, hereby pledge to hold safety as the highest priority on the MRVSEA tractor cruise. The safety of my fellow riders and the public traveling on the route is of the utmost importance. I pledge to obey the following guidelines.

1. To be 16 years of age with a valid driver's license.
2. To follow all traffic laws.
3. To not carry riders unless approved by the ride management team.
4. To not allow any alcohol at any time.
5. To stay with assigned group (no passing).
6. To depart during assigned group's designated time.
7. To drive on the shoulder whenever possible.
8. To not have bicycle companions or cars following.
9. To not pull trailers or campers.
10. To post a SMV sign (you will need to provide).
11. To follow designated route.
12. To abide by the decisions of the ride management team in the event of inclement weather.

I understand not abiding by these rules will result in the denial of future applications. Repetitive violators will be asked to leave the ride per the ride management team.
